**LOCAL WOMAN INSURANCE AGENT JAILED FOR A GOOD CAUSE**  
***Donna Hosfeld giving back to the community via charity work***

There is no insurance available for Donna Hosfeld as she heads to the pokey next week. She's looked long and hard, but there aren't any policies to escape an afternoon in the slammer.

Hosfeld, who owns and operates her own insurance agency in Upper Macungie Township, will be jailed for the local Muscular Dystrophy Association at Carrabba's Italian Grill (510 S Cedar Crest Blvd.) on April 5<sup>th</sup>, all in the name of charity.

She will be picked up from her agency (211 Rt. 100 S) at approximately 1:45 p.m. and carted over to the restaurant for the afternoon, where she will make more than the one allotted phone call, seeking bail money from family, friends, customers and area businesses. She is expected to remain there until approximately 4 p.m.

Hosfeld is more than halfway to her \$3,000 goal heading into the weekend.

"As an independent local agency selling home, auto, business and life insurance products, we want to be involved in the community and help make a difference," said the 43-year-old Hosfeld, who resides in Emmaus with her husband Timothy Derr.

This year the agency gave out free Lance Armstrong LIVESTRONG bracelets to all clients who desired one, while also selling car snow rakes, with profits also benefiting the Lance Armstrong foundation.

"As a way to set us apart from the 800-numbers and Internet based insurers, we want to show ourselves as a responsible, community involved, ethically minded agency willing to make a difference," Hosfeld explained.

"We want to hold tight to the old-time family values and golden rule service that barely exists anymore. As our communities grow, we want to do all we can to keep the small town feel that has made our Lehigh Valley a great place to live and work."
